The Presbyterian Medical Services Care Coordination Program supports and empowers clients and healthcare teams to improve client outcomes and experiences. This program assists New Mexico Medicaid clients with care navigation and takes a proactive approach to health promotion, education, and disease management. Most PMS Care Coordinators work in a hybrid-remote setting either in a PMS health center or at the PMS Engagement Center in Albuquerque. In some instances, Care Coordinators may also travel to a client's home to provide services.
