Career Ladder Medical Assistants

At PMS, a comprehensive Medical Assisting training program is offered that provides participants with essential skills to assist healthcare providers during patient visits, manage administrative tasks, and ensure efficient clinic operations. Individuals can embark on a rewarding career starting as a Medical Assistant I, which requires a high school diploma or GED. Upon completing the training or graduating from an accredited medical assisting program, graduates have opportunities for advancement within the organization. The role of Medical Assistant II follows, with added responsibilities such as administering medications, conducting lab tests, and assisting in minor procedures. Achieving national Medical Assistant certification further enhances career prospects, leading to the Certified Medical Assistant role.
